SAFETY-RELATED INFORMATION

The Soaring Society of America and the Soaring Safety Foundation are dedicated to improving the safety of sailplane competitions. To do so requires comprehensive and accurate information on accidents and incidents that occur during competition.

Reporting should cover the entire period of the contest (including practice days), and should include any accident (an event that resulted in damage or injury) or incident (an event that had the potential to cause damage or injury, such as an inadvertent tow release). Each accident or incident should be described using a separate **Accident/Incident Report Form (SC42)**, which should be filled out by Competition Director and the pilot (or pilots) involved, in cooperation. Included should be a description of sufficient detail to give some sense of just what happened, and the lessons to be learned.

Examples:

With 37 contestants at an FAI **Nationals**, medallions would be awarded to:
1st place through 7th place finishers: 1st gold, 2nd silver, 3rd-7th bronze.

With 25 contestants in one class at an FAI **Regionals**, medallions would be awarded to:
1st place through 3rd place finishers in that class: 1st silver, 2nd-3rd bronze.
