

The Trophy Committee is responsible (1) for maintaining the racing trophies that are awarded to the winners of the US Open, 18-meter, 15-meter, Standard class and Sport class national racing competitions as well as the Hatcher, Giltner, Stroukoff and Mozer trophies, (2) for maintaining the shipping containers for the trophies, (3) for insuring that the trophies are engraved with the names of the winners each year, and (4) for insuring that the trophies are shipped to the appropriate venue each year in time to be presented to the winners.

The trophies that fall under the responsibility of the Trophy Committee include:

The Richard C. du Pont Memorial Trophy (Open class champion)

The Doug Jacobs Trophy (18 meter champion, trophy being designed)

The Schreder 15-Meter Class Trophy (15 meter class champion)

The Standard Class Trophy (unnamed)

The Sport Class Trophy (unnamed)

The Rudolf Mozer Trophy (US Junior Soaring Champion)

The Hatcher Trophy (overall racing "top gun")

The Joe Giltner Memorial Trophy (fastest speed on a task at the 15-meter championships)

The Larissa Stroukoff Memorial Trophy (best speed around a triangular course at the national Open Class soaring competition)

The Marion Evans Trophy (awarded to the winner of the 1-26 nationals) is the responsibility of the 1-26 Association.

The Henry Combs Perpetual Trophy and the Lewin B. Barringer Memorial Trophy are the responsibility of separate committees and the SSA office in Hobbs.

Purchase and transport of Medallions, which are awarded permanently to certain racing contest winners, are the responsibility of the SSA office in Hobbs.
